Scope of work

Procurement & Logistics function

- · Identify potential supplier for required products/ solutions
- Perform cost analysis, price negotiation & make recommendation to management
- Subcontract preparation & negotiation
- Monitor supplier delivery, product quality and take remedial action whenever necessary
- Prepare annual budget & periodic forecast on procurement related KPIs
- Prepare & submit all procurement related reports on regular & ad hoc basis
- Identify performance gap & propose remedial action

Commercial PM function

- Creation and control of all commercial documents, e.g. receive/payment plan, carrying charges, liquidity plan and duly assignment and controlling of revenues/costs (e.g. actual costs-accumulate, non-conformance costs).
- Monitoring of customer payment, according to the payment plan and adequate invoicing
- Ensure correct project accounting in coordination with Accounting department
- Processing Letter of credits, Bank Guarantee, etc. in conjunction with the project management teams
- Controlling and handling of supplier payments including accounts payable
- Handling foreign exchange hedging for projects
- Creation and control of the monthly forecasts e.g. sales, gross profit, business assets, funds tied down in current assets, offer calculation, cost controlling, jointly with the Project Manager.
- Maximise project and business profitability throughout the project lifecycle delivered through professional commercial management.
- Logistical coordination of the project (transport, customs duties, taxes, licenses, etc.) and creation of export documents
- Support and control of the claim management jointly with the Project Manager (dependent on the assignment of the claim manager role)
- Coordination and establishing of documentation including creation of project in SAP and relevant documents.
- Involve in month-end closing, ensuring all the revenue, cost, accrual, etc. are captured in the financial statement.
